The Lawyer's View

Harry Manion, Lawyer for the Church of Scientology: One of the Attorneys on the Portland case and largely responsible for the legal victory. Lifetime member of the International Association of Scientologists.



I was part of the battle of Portland. In fact I was there from day one until the final day. We waged the battle in the courtroom daily. And then when we lost the verdict we waged it for 60 days.

I'm here to tell you that we PRODUCED the mistrial. And there is a very simple explanation as to how we did it — we used the tech!

I learned some lessons that I want to share with you from Portland. I think we as Association members all must share in these lessons so that the mistakes, and what occurred in that courtroom, never repeats itself.

The first lesson is that lawyers cannot win this thing alone. I wear my lawyer's hat, but I'm nothing more than your mouthpiece. My partner and I and the executives and the officials who run the Church of Scientology and all its branches, only speak FOR YOU. And therefore it's not sufficient when an attack is made upon Scientology philosophy to say "Oh, let the lawyers handle it." Or "let the executives handle it — that's what we have them for." That's not sufficient. And you know it.

Because the answer is in the tech — it's up to YOU to handle it and that's what happened and that's how the disaster of Portland has been turned into, metamorphosized into, the greatest constitutional victory of the 1900s.

It was done by people like yourselves who just said "Enough. Stop. Time out. We won't tolerate this any longer."

So, the first lesson I'm trying to share with you this evening is don't ask us to do it alone. If you're there with us we're undefeatable. Alone — we're just lawyers.

Friends have asked how I like representing the Church of Scientology. I am impressed by the honesty, integrity and decency of the people I met. I had never encountered in my seven years of practicing law a more decent upstat fun-loving group of people. We worked 18 hours a day, seven days a week and although we labored under tremendous pressure and the stakes were very high, the Scientologists that I lived with for 3½ months never lost their optimism, their good naturedness or their sense of humor and they continued to be an inspiration for me.

This second lesson I learned was translated into action. I asked my terminal in the Church to obtain for me an Annual Membership in the International Association of

Scientologists. Because, as I sat there in that courtroom day in and day out, getting madder and madder as a parade of really inconsequential people made a mockery out of my client's and my friends' religion, I said to myself and my family, if those little people can take away this great religion today, they can take away mine tomorrow and yours the next day. And I'm not going to stand for it and the International Association of Scientologists is the vehicle that's not going to stand for it.

So I wrote my check and I filled out my membership card and I became a member of the Association and I'm very happy I did!

Over the last three months, my partner and I have reviewed all of the litigation. It's all one and the same. It doesn't even require that much legal work because the theory is the same. It's psychiatric backed, it's backed by small people who are scared of you. They're scared of you and what you stand for.

Freedom's a frightening concept. And there are some people that just can't allow it to exist.

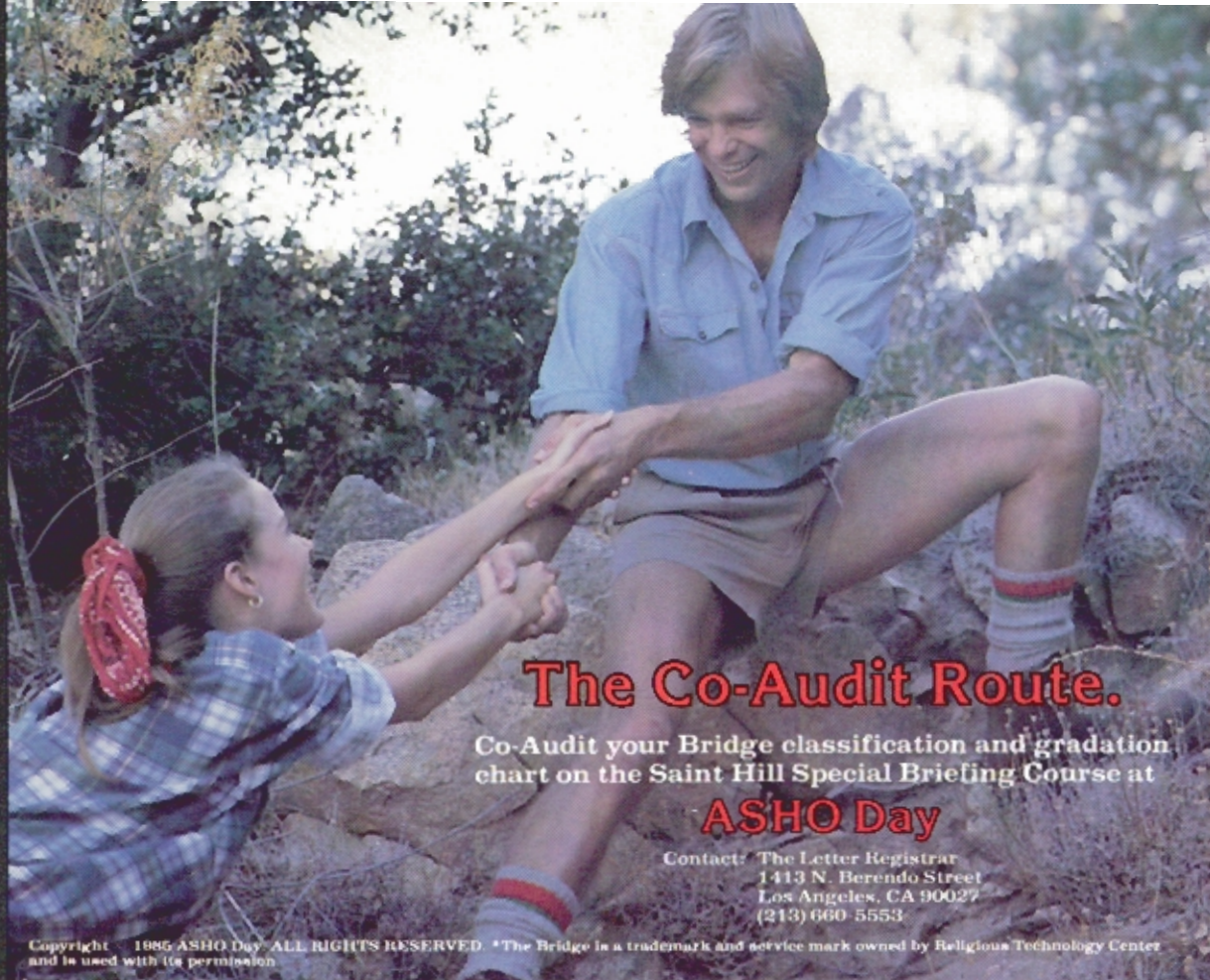
I had a cognition that these SPs have to be stopped once and for all. And I don't think legal is the answer. Because the courts are only a stage. They'll move to other stages after we exterminate them there. They'll move on and on. The only answer is the International Association of Scientologists. So I became a Lifetime Member and I proudly wear my pin!

We're confronted with a problem. And when I say we, I'm not speaking about lawyers. I've already told you I don't have much confidence in those folks. I'm speaking to you as a fellow member of the Association which I have a right to do because I'm here to ask you to help me with my problem. Because its not mine, its OURS.

We're confronted with squirrels who are altering the tech, packaging it up and passing it off in an altered form. Now how are we going to handle this problem. Well, we could hire lawyers — let them fight it out in the court — we all know that's a joke.

We could say to ourselves, "let's let the executives handle it. We don't have to trouble ourselves with it. They're fully competent. The people who have spoken here today are excellent administrators and great executives. It's

their hat. Let them handle it." We could ask *them* to do it. I don't think that's a solution.

We could ignore it and say that these squirrels are probably hurting only 10,000 or 20,000 people. Don't confront it. Ignore it. Go on with our lives. Go on with your processing. Worry about your case. Don't worry about anybody else's. But that's just out tech.

So what *should* we do? We should confront it — each and every one of us whenever we see or hear entheta we should step on it. Stomp it out. Using every legal means available to us. *Don't* pass it on to me. *Don't* pass it on to your executives. *Handle it yourself.* That's the lesson I learned about Portland.

Each and every one of us must be vigilant. And when it comes on our lines, handle it.

I also was reading an IMPACT magazine that, as a member of the Association, I read religiously. And I studied the "Code of a Scientologist" which was on the back cover of an IMPACT magazine.

And what the Code says is to do something! The only sin as I see it in my studies of Scientology is to do nothing and let the forces of evil and chaos go their merry way and wave

at them. That's the only sin I can see. Every paragraph of the "Code of a Scientologist" says to do something. Point 16 is particularly appropriate to handling squirrels. "To insist upon standard and unvaried Scientology as an applied activity in ethics, processing and administration in Scientology organizations."*

The message I bring to you, my fellow Association members, is very simple. The message is that *YOU* are the reality, not the lawyers, not the organizations, not the execs, not the legal system, not judges, not juries. *You* and you alone are the reality. I have the honor of being one of your mouth pieces. But I speak only *FOR* you. You are my reality and I consider it a very very cherished and precious bond to have the honor to speak for you.

And I look forward to speaking next year at our second anniversary event. And next year I intend for my speech to be very short and very sweet. I will say the following: "Good evening, my fellow Association members, the legal war is over! We have won. The genius of I.R.H. has prevailed! The planet is safe for once for all and forever!"
